

The Bangor YMCA Wilderness Center at Camp Jordan is set on 200 acres along the shores of Branch Lake and sits in the heart of Eastern Maine's pristine lake district just 18 miles from Bangor, 12 miles from Downtown Ellsworth, and 30 miles from Bar Harbor and Acadia National Park.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- Place car placard on dashboard while parked in the parking lot.
- Check in and out of the Camp Office before entering and leaving the trail system.
- Stay on marked trails.
- Please choose an appropriate level of trail difficulty that matches your experience.
- All snowshoes must be removed before entering the Camp Office or Dining Hall Porch.
- Dining Hall use is for warmth, bathrooms, and hot beverages (kitchen access is restricted).
- Please make sure to pick up any trash.
- Pets are allowed, but must be under your control at all times. Also please be prepared to clean up after your pet. Pets are allowed in the Dining Hall.
- Ice access is limited and is dependent on weather.
