## PERSONAL GEAR LIST

### GEAR

- **Backpack** – NOT A DRAWSTRING BAG – This bag (21 – 35 Liters) must be large enough to fit extra clothing, a lunch, water and any other items needed. **A school backpack will work for our program.**
- **Two (2) 1-liter water bottles** – We recommend wide mouth Gatorade bottles, Nalgene, etc. We will be bringing large water jugs for campers to refill their bottles while on our trips. It is important for campers to bring two 1-liter bottles each day in order to stay hydrated.
- **Optional** – Notebook, pens/pencils.

### CLOTHES

- **Hiking shoes/durable sneakers** – Must be broken in and comfortable enough to be worn a majority of the day. Shoes may get muddy and will likely get a lot of wear throughout the week.
- **Optional extra shoes** – Sneakers/crocs/sandals **MUST HAVE A BACKSTRAP** to wear when at camp.
- **Extra pair of synthetic/wool socks** – **Socks may get wet on trip.**
- A sun hat with a brim/ball cap.
- Sunglasses.
- 1 fleece jacket/wool sweater.
- Rain/Wind gear (top and bottom), waterproof and breathable.
- Bring an extra set of clothes each day.
- Bathing suit + towels.

### PERSONAL ITEMS

- Sunscreen.
- Bug spray.
- Prescription medications – Must be given to group leader, unless camper has a self-administration form filled out. Contact the Y to request this form early.
- **Optional** – Rx glasses/contact sets and solution if needed.
- **Optional** – Menstrual products.

Adventure Day Camp is an outdoor program that runs rain or shine. This program is designed to challenge campers. Please ensure that your camper is prepared for our program challenges and is physically able to hike 1 to 4 miles on any given day.

# BANGOR REGION YMCA DAY CAMPS

## INCOME-BASED CAMP FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Bangor Region YMCA is a charitable, non-profit organization, whose mission is to be a community leader in supporting children, adults and families in their lifelong quest for physical, emotional and social wellness. The Bangor Region YMCA and its Board of Directors feels strongly that the YMCA is for everyone. No one will be turned away because of an inability to pay, subject to the availability of funds. The Bangor Region YMCA believes that a strong sense of ownership and pride is developed if the financial assistance recipient contributes to the cost of their YMCA involvement; therefore, applicants should be asked to pay an affordable portion of the camp fees.

### HOW TO APPLY

Each person requesting financial assistance, must complete a Financial Assistance Application and present a most recent tax return or statement of non-filing\*.

You can find a copy of our Financial Assistance Application online at:

or come in to the Bangor Region YMCA to pick up a printed copy.

To process the application, the Membership & Registration Manager will:

- Visually verify the Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) from the person's tax return
- Verify the member's signature on the Financial Assistance Application
- Complete the bottom of the Financial Assistance Application
- Return the tax information back to the person

At no time should the Bangor Region YMCA retain or copy the applicant's tax return for any Financial Assistance Application.

## CHOOSE WHAT YOU PAY! TIER EXPLANATION

Tier pricing is not income-based but is based on what your family is comfortable with paying. You choose what you pay and no additional paperwork is required! **All campers receive the same camp experience regardless of the tier their family pays.**

**TIER 1** most accurately accounts for the true cost of operating camp including wear and tear on equipment and depreciation.

**TIER 2** is a partially subsidized rate for those who can afford to pay more than just the basic costs associated with attending camp.

**TIER 3** is an adjusted fee that covers just the basic costs associated with attending camp such as staff, salaries, and supplies.

Families unable to afford Tier 3 can apply for our Income-Based Camp Financial Assistance Program.

## CANCELLATION POLICY

Our desire is to enable every child who wants to come to camp the opportunity to do so. Unfortunately, we fill our allotted camper spots early and have to implement a waiting list. Due to this popularity of our camps, we must enforce a strict cancellation policy. If you have to cancel your scheduled time at camp, in addition to our non-refundable registration fee and deposit, you will be charged a cancellation fee based upon the following schedule:

1. **If you cancel before June 1<sup>st</sup>**, only your non-refundable registration fee and the \$25 per week deposit will be applied. If your \$25 per week deposit has not been paid at time of cancellation, you will be charged.
2. **If you cancel June 1<sup>st</sup> or after**, you will be required to pay 50% of the program fees.
3. **If you cancel less than 1 week before program start**, you will be required to pay 100% of the program fees.

**REGISTRATION FEE:** I understand a \$35 one-time, non-refundable registration fee is required in order to enroll my child. **DEPOSIT IS REQUIRED BY JUNE 1<sup>ST</sup>:** A \$25 non-refundable deposit per week per camper must be paid by June 1<sup>st</sup> to reserve the camper's spot. The remaining balance for each week the camper is attending camp must be paid no later than the Monday prior to the week attending. All fees must be paid in full prior to participation in any programs. Fees may be paid by VISA/MasterCard/Discover or AMEX credit/debit card. Payment plans are also available.

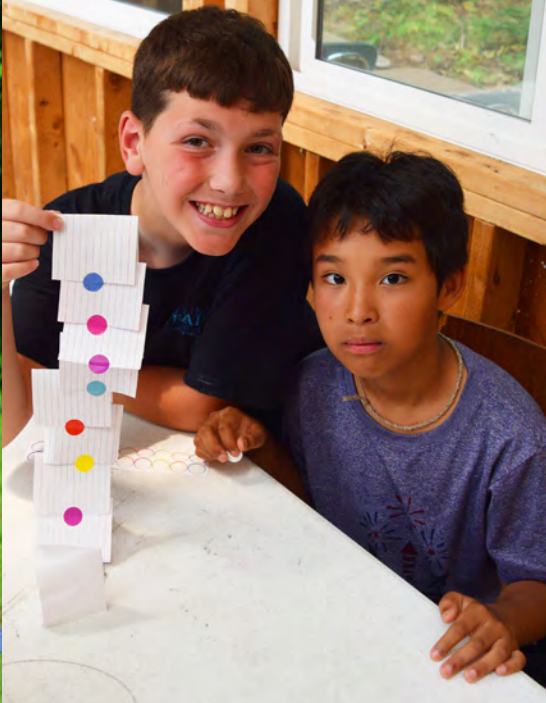
